

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 4:00 pm, Wednesday, February 26, 2025. Reserved RV Parking and Reserved Box Van Parking will open for check in on Wednesday, February 26, 2025 at 4:00 pm. Please do not arrive prior to opening and expect access to the buildings. Dogs must be removed from the show site by one hour after Best in Show on Sunday, March 2, 2025.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog, an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.50 for each additional entry of the same dog will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. An AKC Recording fee of \$3.50 for each entry will be required for each dog in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 4) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN/FOREIGN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entries received prior to the published opening date and time of entries or received prior to the publishing of this premium list will be returned without processing.

A service/processing fee of \$7.00 will be charged to each duplicate entry.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks nor will they be accepted toward entry fees.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$4.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.50 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

Each Entry processed through Jack Onofrio Dog Shows Telephone Entry Service or Onofrio Online Entry will have a service fee included in the amount charged to the payment card provided. Each user of either service acknowledges they are authorized to charge fees to the card provided for payment and further acknowledges the transaction is made over the phone or internet. Chargebacks on cards are a violation of the agreement to pay all fees included in this premium list and can result in the club refusing future entries from the exhibitor, refusal of entries from the exhibitor by the superintendent until the debt has been paid and/or being placed on a cash only basis with the superintendent.



ROUTES TO THE SHOW

ALL EXHIBITORS AND SPECTATORS ENTER AT THE 17TH AVENUE AND W MCDOWELL ROAD ENTRANCE

FROM I-10 WESTBOUND: Exit 19th Ave, turn right on McDowell Rd, turn left on 17th Ave. **FROM I-10 EASTBOUND:** Exit 27th Ave, turn right on McDowell Rd, turn left on 17th Ave. **FROM I-17 SOUTHBOUND:** Exit Thomas Rd, turn left, turn right on 19th Ave, turn left on McDowell Rd, turn left on 17th Ave.

FROM I-17 NORTHBOUND: Exit Van Buren St, turn right, turn left on 19th Ave, turn right on McDowell Rd. turn left on 17th Ave.



Beginner Puppies (4-6 months of age) AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition!

Section 1 - Classifications

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for puppies that are over four months of age but under six months on the day of the event.
- Classes are offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3 Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show
- The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- Puppies must have one of the following:
 - An Individual registration number registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC)
 - A Foundation Stock Service (FSS) registration number
 - A foreign born dog may enter if they are registered in the country of origin, as defined in Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows
- · All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. <u>Entries must be</u> marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete <u>for awards</u> in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants
 to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and
 amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner
 Puppy Competition.

Entries will close Wednesday, February 12, 2025 Noon MST, at Superintendent's office.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards *

with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

ÔPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class

REGULAR CLASSES

at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

★ A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.

SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

Sweepstakes judges who are judging our Specialty will not enter or exhibit a Toy Fox Terrier owned or co-owned by them at this Specialty. The American Toy Terrier Club Sweepstakes is open to dogs that on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record are eligible. Professional handlers, members of their families or their employees may NOT show dogs in sweepstakes unless such person is the owner or breeder of the dog entered. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to dogs that on the day of the show, will be 7 years and older. Champions of Record may be entered. Professional handlers, members of their families or their employees may NOT show dogs in Veteran Sweepstakes unless such person is the owner or breeder of the dog entered. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in another class. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

The following class will be provided for both dogs and bitches in each variety.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BEST PUPPY IN PUPPY CLASSES

Best Puppy in Puppy Classes will be selected from the Puppy Class (6-9 & 9-12) & Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed competition

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy & Bred-by-Exhibitor Adult Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed competition

BEST VETERAN

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed
