The 2025 National Specialty committee, led by Barb Kelley, is well underway with their planning for next year's show. The judge the membership selected is Mr James (Jimmy) Moses and he told Barb he is honored to be asked to judge our National. Spring in Arizona is supposed to be really pretty and word is we're with a great cluster.

The Board is discussing 2026 and 2027 hoping we can get dates and locations chosen so we can get the judges the membership desires before they are committed to other shows. Laura Johnson has some great ideas about introducing our breed to Juniors, more to come on that as we develop her idea to something we can push out to our specialties and members.

Speaking of juniors, in case you didn't know, Tabs Dvorak is our Junior Coordinator. If a junior is interested in doing things with their Toy Fox, it's a great opportunity to connect them with her.

The other big thing the ATFTC is kicking off is our Versality Recognition Awards. We know how smart and versatile our Toy Foxes are and we want to celebrate their achievements with you! If your dog has two or more titles in different events – conformation, rally, agility, Barnhunt, scent work, obedience, etc – you will be able to send in a form and copies of your titles and get a lovely certificate from the ATFTC recognizing you and your pup's achievements. As you add titles –you can continue to earn certificates and recognition. Additionally, the recipients of these awards and their photos will be posted in the newsletter. If you have any questions about it, please contact our performance co-chair Chris Bowker who is spearheading this initiative.

I want to give a shout out for Barb Kelley and Pam Cox. Barb presented an educational breed seminar on the Toy Fox Terrier breed standard in February as part of the Arizona Judges Institute. 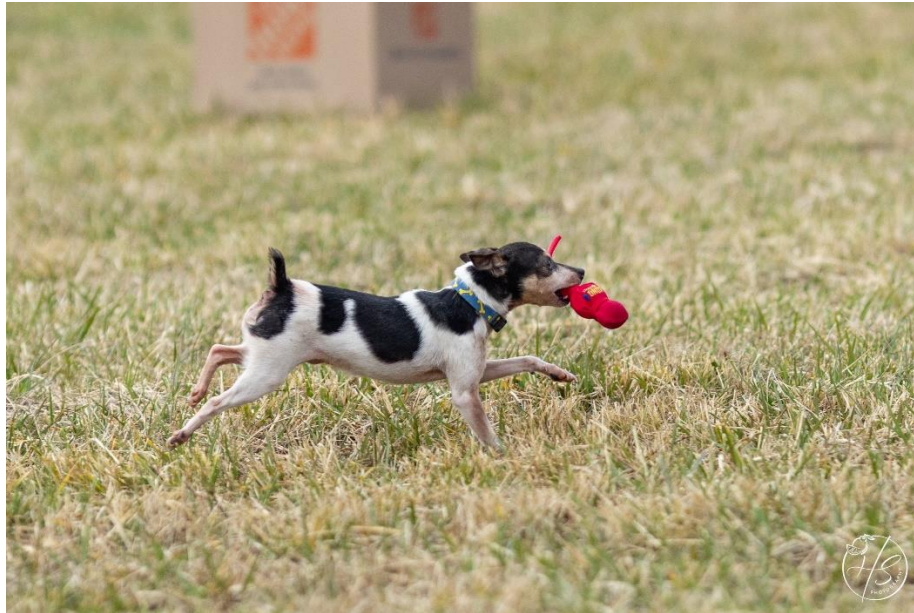

Attached please find the latest, newly re-formatted, version of the Parent Club Registration Stats for your breed, your group(s), and all AKC breeds through the end of 2023.

In addition to the registration data, we are once again including Parent Club Membership data relating to breeder and litter counts. This data, from 2016 through 2023, gives a general picture of the breeding activity of Parent Club members relative to the overall breeding activity within the breed. **\*\*NOTE:** This data is only as accurate as the membership lists submitted by each Parent Club through the web-based Club Membership Upload Tool and our ability to use email addresses to match members to litters. To ensure accurate information for this and similar projects please make sure your membership data is current. The link to upload the club membership list is found at [https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/club\\_membership/index.cfm?useraction=accesscode](https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/club_membership/index.cfm?useraction=accesscode), the instructions page link is [https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/club\\_membership/index.cfm](https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/club_membership/index.cfm). If your club submits household data (not individuals) please note we are counting a household as a member.

Finally, we have a new report in this edition of the PC Stats: Registration Counts by Color. This new report is similar to what we have for many years produced for clubs upon request. This is located on the last page of the AKC Registration Stats.

As with previous distributions of the Parent Club Registration Stats data, please feel free to share the attached information with your club membership as you see fit in order to stimulate discussion about breed specific registration and preservation initiatives.

**Important Notes:**

As noted in the previous distributions of this information, the attached includes the counts of litters, litter complement, and dogs registered for each year since 2011. The reports also include the counts of unique dogs and bitches that were bred or that participated in a sport. Those counts are finite and will change only minimally over time and generally only due to cancellations of litters, dogs and/or awards. However, the reports also contain numbers that are **"To Date"** which will often change each time we produce these statistics (see definitions below).

Complement: This is the count of pups from each AKC litter.

To Date: There are a number of rows that indicate "to date," such as "Total Complement in Conformation (to date)." All rows with "to date" information are refreshed every time we reprocess this report. This is so you will have an accurate picture of the puppies produced in any given year. For instance, of the 1,211,576 puppies produced in AKC Litters in 2011 (a.k.a., the Litter Complement for 2011), 43,010 or 3.5% have thus far gone on to participate in conformation as of March 2024. Every time we update this chart, the system looks at all litters from 2011 to see if any additional dogs have started in conformation. Obviously, there will not be many 2011 pups entering Conformation or Breeding for the first time in 2023, but there will be many updates to the information known about pups born in more recent years. Likewise, the "to

date” measures for pups born in 2023 will be very low compared to other years because very little time has passed since those litters were whelped; most dogs born in 2023 are still too young for breeding or most AKC sports or titles.

**Unique:** “Unique” indicates the number of individual dogs participating in an activity such as breeding or exhibiting, counting each unique dog only once. For example, the same dog might have participated multiple times in a sport during a single year, but is only counted as one unique dog for that entire year, regardless of when each unique dog was born.

“Competing In” vs “Placing In” : While we are able to accurately count unique dogs participating (i.e., entering) in Conformation and Companion events, we do not have complete entry data for all Performance events for the time period. Therefore, you will notice that for Performance Events we provide counts of uniques *placing* in performance. We realize this understates the total dogs participating in Performance sports but this is the best we can do for this sport category.

Again, please feel free to share the attached information with your club membership as you see fit in order to stimulate discussion about registration, how AKC registration processes and procedures can be improved to better support breeders, and to explore how AKC could further assist Parent Clubs in their mission to develop, steward, and preserve their breeds.

In the 20 years since full

recognition by the AKC, Toy Foxes have excelled in conformation, with some even winning groups and Best in Shows. Primarily handled in the ring by their owners, many have earned their championships and grand championships, including up to Platinum. Members who were celebrating 20 years in the ATFTFC were recognized at our annual awards banquet for their ongoing support and dedication to the breed since that key year.

In addition to the conformation ring, Toy Foxes have shown they can excel in many AKC events over the

### American Eskimo Dogs

Our guest columnist this month is Eleanor Main. Eleanor is a well-known and most respected “Eskie person” who has loved, owned, and bred Eskies throughout her life. She has often been sought as a mentor to both adults and children new to the breed and the world of AKC events, has been a UKC judge since 1982, and put championship and performance titles on her own Eskies—always going into the ring as an owner-handler.

### MY LIFELONG LOVE AFFAIR WITH AMERICAN ESKIMO DOGS: A MESSAGE TO THOSE WHO LOVE ESKIES

More than 70 years ago I became enmeshed with the world of the American Eskimo Dog (AED/Eskie) when my father brought home a female puppy purchased at a pet store. Back in those days, they were called a “Spitz.” We named our little girl Teddi. I loved her more than you can ever begin to imagine.

Teddi was *the* ideal dog in

the results, again, could be unpredictable. Puppy mills and backyard breeders are concerned only with profit, not quality, and will accept any buyer with a credit card or check. Ethical breeders screen new homes (be prepared for lots of questions), will serve as knowledgeable mentors after you take your puppy home, and will take back or rehome any dog they produced at any time. In other words, they care.

Because ethical breeders spend lots of time socializing, caring for, and observing their puppies, they will be able to recommend the puppy most likely to fit best into your life. In most cases, they will *not* let you take your Shih Tzu puppy home before it is 12 weeks old, so that it is old enough to adjust well. They will tell you what you need to buy before you bring your puppy home, have started your puppy's paper training, had his health checked, and begun to accustom him to having his nails cut, his feet trimmed, and his coat

brushed. All of this gets your puppy off to the best possible start.

Some people truly enjoy raising puppies, while others would prefer not to deal with housebreaking, crate-training, chewing, teething, and all of the other things that go along with raising a youngster. If you would prefer an older dog, a breeder may have a retired show dog who would love to spend the rest of his life as a pampered only pet, or be able to refer you to a reputable Shih Tzu rescue organization that knows the breed well, has screened its dogs, and can, once again, find the Shih Tzu best suited to *you*.

Remember that responsible breeders do not contribute to pet overpopulation. They find homes for every animal they breed and keep track of them once they leave. They take great care in producing dogs that are calm, friendly, playful, and inquisitive—healthy, well-adjusted animals that look like Shih Tzu and

respond quickly and easily to basic training. They also support breed rescue. The dogs who wind up in shelters do not come from responsible breeders but from poorly bred, randomly raised, or “damaged” dogs who spent their early lives in one or more unsuitable homes.

## Toy Fox Terriers

### SENIOR TOY FOX TERRIERS

One of the blessings of owning a Toy Fox Terrier is that generally they are a healthy, long lived breed. Many owners post on social media that they are celebrating the birthday of their beloved Toy Fox in their teens. Longtime Toy Fox Terrier breeders and owners report having dogs who live to 16 and 17

years old. They report that their senior Toy Foxes were healthy until almost the end of their lives and remained playful well into their senior years.

In response, these owners were asked their advice for promoting a senior dog's wellbeing. The first answer from each is a healthy diet and to avoid the dog becom-

ing overweight at any stage of its life, but particularly during the senior years. One long-term Toy Fox breeder says she feeds the same food for the dogs' lifetimes and ensures they are in proper weight and good condition at all life stages. Several advise treats are for training and as rewards and should be tiny and not make up a

significant part of the Toy Fox's daily calories.

Besides a good diet and watching calories, an important aspect of maintaining your Toy Fox Terrier's healthy weight, muscle tone, and flexibility in their senior years is exercise. Regular physical activity such as playing games, going on walks, and encouraging them to play with their toys not only keeps their muscles toned and burns calories, but also plays a crucial role in healthy joints. In addition to maintaining a lean and conditioned Toy Fox, many recommend putting senior dogs on joint supplements beginning at around age 7.

It's not a secret that toy dogs tend to have teeth that can be problematic. Just as in people, good oral health is associated with better overall health in their senior years. According to veterinarians, the biggest dental problem for toy dogs is periodontal disease. Food gathers and plaque and tartar form around their teeth,

causing dental issues.

Many Toy Fox Terriers lose teeth by the time they are seniors. Routine dental care guards against periodontal disease, tooth loss, and infection.

In addition to avoiding soft foods and providing suitable items for chewing, many people brush their dogs' teeth. I brush my Toy Fox Terriers' teeth every night with a sonic-type toothbrush and poultry-flavored enzymatic toothpaste made specifically for dogs.

In addition to brushing, have the veterinarian inspect the dog's teeth annually. They may recommend descaling for any plaque and tartar that has built up where the toothbrush couldn't reach.

Another way to help your senior Toy Fox Terriers have healthy senior years is to keep their nails short. If you hear clicking on the floor as they walk, their nails are too long. Older dogs seem to have toenails that grow fast, and if their toenails are too long, they will exercise less. Long nails change the angles

of their foot joints and are uncomfortable. Many Toy Fox Terrier owners learn to use a nail-grinder weekly as a less stressful way to do the nails.

As changes in older dogs can happen seemingly overnight, senior Toy Fox Terriers should be examined by their vet annually. Many veterinarians recommend an annual "senior blood panel." This can help in detecting infections, illnesses, and chronic conditions before your dog even shows symptoms. Catching developing issues early may add years to your dog's life.

Hopefully your Toy Fox Terrier will enjoy a long, healthy life into their teen years. You can tip the odds in your favor by keeping your dog at a healthy weight, encouraging exercise, practicing good dental health, keeping their nails short, and partnering with your veterinarian.
