**What is this?** Meet current and future stud dogs, along with breeders from across the country, in a warm and welcoming setting that celebrates camaraderie and community! Stud dogs will not need to be present to appear in the booklet! A printed and digital download of the booklet will be provided.

**Who is the event for?** Everyone who is interested! Bring your stud dog(s) and introduce them to members of the breed community. Drop in to chat with fellow breeders and meet their stud dogs.

**Is there a fee to participate?** Stud dog owners will be charged a nominal fee of \$10 per dog to cover expenses.

**My stud has multiple owners. What kennel should he be listed with?** Stud dogs will be grouped by kennel of residence and must be listed under the kennel name where they reside.

**What is the deadline to enter the showcase?** The deadline to enter the stud dog showcase and appear in the booklet is July 15, 2026.

**What dogs may be entered in the showcase?** The showcase event will be for stud dogs physically present, however, frozen semen and stud dogs who are available throughout the country may be listed in the booklet for the same \$10 per kennel fee, regardless of whether they are present at the event.

**What dogs can I bring to the showcase? May I bring my stud dog's offspring?** You may bring your stud dog and 1 to 2 offspring to showcase alongside him. If you bring more than

one, due to limited space, please bring a trolley or crates to hold the offspring when they are not being shown to interested folks.

**What materials should I bring?** We suggest that stud dog owners bring their dogs' pedigrees, health testing information and any information you feel will help other breeders understand whether your dog might be a good match for their breeding goals. A grooming table would be helpful too.

**What will be in the booklet?** We're thinking the dog's name, titles, health clearances, photo and a three generation pedigree.

**Bitch owners:** If you are looking for a stud dog to pair with a bitch in your breeding program, it would be helpful to bring her pedigree and health test information. Please do not bring your bitch to this showcase. 😊
